The supernatural harvest will bring a harvest of blessings, spiritual and to all other areas of our lives. The harvest is always in multiplied form, and that's the way our mighty God will bless us.

The supernatural harvest will bring a mighty outpouring of the Holy Spirit and gifts of the Holy Spirit, which will bring;

- (i) A harvest of the lost to the Kingdom of God.
- (ii) A harvest of dreams, visions, supernatural intervention and revelation of spiritual and creative ideas to use our giftings, talents and abilities to serve our wonderful Lord and in business and work.
- (iii) A harvest of miracles of healing and health.
- (iv) A harvest of wealth, land, houses and vehicles etc.
- (v) The blessings will be so great and come so quickly, that before one harvest cycle is over the other has already begun. “Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, ‘ when the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it.” Amos 9:13

II. WE MUST KEEP SOWING THE SEED

The seed we have sown are, our prayers, reading God's word, giving, serving God, preaching God's word, helping others, showing love and kindness etc.

Beloved partners we are doing great in sowing seed sacrificially and let's keep up the excellent work. This clearly shows your love for our wonderful Lord and Master.

This is one of the keys in living in the supernatural harvest. These seeds will continually bring us the supernatural harvest.

Sacrificing for the lost and preaching to the lost is one of the greatest supernatural seeds we sow that pleases our precious Lord. That's why He promised a hundred fold return. *"So Jesus answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say unto you, there is no one who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundred fold now in this time – houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecution – and in the age to come, eternal life.'" Mark 10:29-30*

A hundred fold is not just 100 times but much more. It is a continual return from season to season, which does not stop. It is like a mango, orange or apple tree. It just gives more than 100 fruits, but a continual harvest of fruit from season to season.

The supernatural harvest is beginning this year and will continue until our glorious Lord Jesus comes.

In this supernatural harvest, we will reap what others have sown. *"For in this the saying is true; One sows and another reaps. I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others*

have labored, and you have entered, and you have entered into their labors." John 4:37-38

III. THE LAWS OF THE SUPERNATURAL HARVEST

When God created the universe, He put laws into motion. Like the law of gravity, the law of the Spirit of life and the law of sin and death (Romans 8:2), the laws of sowing and reaping. *"While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall never cease."* Genesis 8:22)

- (i) God is our total source. *"And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."* Philippians 4:19 Our job, business, ministry, etc are not our source, they are God's channels He uses to bless us.
- (ii) God gives seed to those who sow. *"Now may He who supplies seed to the sower..."* 2 Corinthians 9:10 a. As we ask the Lord in prayer He will give us more seed to sow.
- (iii) God multiplies and brings the harvest of the seeds we sow. *"Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness."* 2 Corinthians 9:10. Isn't it wonderful that God multiplies back to us more than what we give to His work. The return is more than what we give.

- (iv) The harvest always comes in due season. *“And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.” Galatians 6:9.* God is always on time and never too early or late. God has always our best interest at heart. Due season may mean immediate or may take time. God works on His time table and knows the right time.
- (v) The harvest is in proportion to the seed we sow. *“Give and it will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use it will be measured back to you.” Luke 6:38.* This is a special blessing to those of us who give sacrificially. When we give sacrificially, it may not be a large amount compared to others, but God sees the measure we use, and gives us a large harvest. The widow just gave two mites and our precious Lord said she gave more than the others. In this way all can receive large harvests.
- (vi) Sow what you expect to harvest. *“And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind.*

And God saw that bit was good.” Genesis 1:12. Seed produces after its kind. So we must sow good seed and what we want to harvest.

- (vii) Plant in good soil for best results. *“...Behold, a sower went out to sow....But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop; some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.” Matthew 13:3,8.* Our precious Holy Spirit just revealed that God’s return is better than any Bank in the whole world. To God be all the glory, praise and honour. You will receive more than the banks return.

IV. THE KEYS TO LIVE IN THE SUPERNATURAL HARVEST

- (i) Keep your faith alive by daily worship, prayer and reading God’s word.
- (ii) Refuse to get discouraged.
- (iii) Keep thanking and praising our precious Lord for your supernatural harvest.
- (iv) Ask our wonderful Lord for more seed.
- (v) Continue to sow and walk in love.

I am so excited that we are now ready to live in the supernatural harvest that we are about to experience beginning this year.

Thanks, thanks for sowing good seed on good soil and being such a blessing.
